

Medical Supplies Disaster Reserve – Malawi, Africa

GMR is organizing donation of medical supplies to build a disaster relief storehouse in Malawi

Problem: Malawi, Africa is in a medical crisis. The HIV/AIDS epidemic continues to have a catastrophic impact on Malawian society. Malaria is a major public health concern, especially among pregnant women and children under five. The human and economic costs are enormous; in addition to the expenses of consultation, treatment, hospitalization, and travel, disease also leads to missed days at work, lower incomes, and the growing number of orphans in Malawi.

Response: GMR is committed to supporting the fight against disease in Malawi through ground support and delivering medical supplies. We are in the beginning stages of constructing an Institute of Technology in Malawi that will include a storehouse for stocking a surplus of medical supplies. These items include a wide variety of bandages, gauze pads, ointments, emergency first aid kits, burn dressings, pain medicines, and sterilized surgical equipment.

Result: GMR secured the support of Zee Medical Service in Canada, which has donated four hundred pounds of new medical supplies in the past year. Although outdated supplies are readily available, GMR collects only new supplies, in accordance with government safety standards in Africa. Our Canadian team delivered supplies that will help alleviate pain and suffering in this impoverished area of Africa. Global Ministries and Relief is continually collecting donations for future deliveries and to build up a surplus for the storehouse.
